Snow Plowing Information:

Cost per hour for plowing. Cost per ton of salt. Equipment you have available, and cost per hour (dump truck-\$XX.00 per hour, bobcat-\$XX.00 per hour, etc.)

Proof of insurance (if your bid is chosen)

While we know we can't expect to always be the first on your list of places to plow, we do expect that our streets are cleaned in a timely manner.

The highlighted areas can be seen on the Village map, here is a written explanation also.

There are two loops on West side of N. Main St. between 27 N. Main and 101 N. Main, and 115 N. Main and 119N. Main and an alley at 122 N. Main across to Pemberton Rd. Laura Circle Chestnut St, including past Second St to the end of the road. Second St. From Ludlow St. East to the middle of the hill as you go out of town. School St. Bee St. from N. Main to Pike St. Pemberton Road from St. Rt. 571-- North to Village limits (around Wagner Paving.) S. Main St. from the 4 -way stop at Pike St.-South to the village limits (Sewer Plant included) Pike St. From St. Rt. 571 to the 4-way Stop at Main St. Short St.-Alley off of Second St. and alley that connects to S. Main St. Ludlow St. All the alleys between Chestnut-Ludlow, and Pike-First St The Sewer plant will need cleaned and salted. The Water Plant-From Ludlow St- plow the little drive that goes into the field and salt. (Even if we don't plow the streets, we'd like the water and sewer plant drives salted if there is enough precipitation that the vehicles can't get up the hills.)

Village Building parking lot -cleaned and salted. (in back)

We will work with you on when to plow/salt. We generally have a rule -2" or more of snow means you plow automatically. Someone will call you if we want it done otherwise. Please ask if you have a question.
